This day commences with fine weather

to the Westward at Sundown strong breeze
from the SW Middle part the same
attended with rain squalls single reefed
the Top Sails Later part made all Sail
with the Wind Still to the SW
this ends the 13 day

Tuesday Oct the 7

This day commences with a fine breeze from
the SW all Sail out Sundown the same
this evening pump Ship and had one hour
pumping Middle the same Later part
Saw a Sail standing to the Southward
the Wind to the Westward
this ends the 14 day and 2 Miles

Wednesday Oct the 8

This day commences with a fine breeze
from the SW all Sail out lashed the
Shackles for the cutting pendant to the
Mainmast head at Sundown the
to the North got some later observation
the afternoon Middle part fine breeze
Later part light from the North
hands employed at their several
duties.
