

Journal of the Ship Mary Frazer of Newbedford <sup>1858</sup>

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Wednesday Oct the 15  
this day commences with strong winds  
from the Westward Ship under double  
reefed Top Sails sundown the same  
pump Ship Middle part the same  
Later part more moderate made  
all sail the Wind S.W. brook out  
the After hole for provisions  
thus ends the 22 day

Lat 26.56 N Long 34.27 W Course

Thursday Oct the 16  
this day commences with light winds  
from the S.W. the Ship steering  
on the Wind brook out the fore  
hole for Bread Sundown fine weather  
pump Ship Middle part fine later  
part fine weather the wind S  
thus ends the 23 day

Lat 26.40 N Long 32.25 W Course S

Friday Oct the 17  
this day commences with pleasant  
weather the Wind S sundown the  
same pump Ship Middle part  
light air Later part calm set  
up the Main Stays  
thus ends the 24 day

Lat 26.12 N Long 33.21 W Course full and by on the L. tack

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Saturday Oct the 18  
this day commences with a calm  
Sundown the same lowered the  
Boats to practice the boats crews  
pump Ship hands employed setting  
up the Main Stays at 4 P.M. the  
Carpenter fell from the Fore yard did  
not hurt himself, much middle part light  
air from the N.E. later part a little  
more breeze brook out Scur and  
codfish got Lunar observations  
thus ends the 25 day

Lat 25.41 N Long 33.25 W Course S

Sunday Oct the 19  
this day commences with a fine breeze  
from the N.E. saw two Barks standing  
to the Northward this afternoon wash  
Ship Sundown fine breeze pump Ship  
Middle and Later part calm got some  
Lunar observations with agreed very nearly  
with the Chronometer  
thus ends the 26 day

Long by Lunar Observation 33 18

Lat 24.25 N Long 33 14 W

Oct the 20 Monday  
this day commences with a calm a School  
of Dolphins around the Ship the first fast  
kind that we have seen at 2 P.M. a light  
breeze sprang up from the Northward Sundown  
the same pump Ship Middle and Later  
calm set up the fifth Stay unbeat the  
Main Sail and took two cloth out of it  
thus ends the 27 day  
got Lunar observations
