

Bark Mary Frazier Capt Wm Allen

Remarks on Thursday 23 June 1865

This day commences with light wind and foggy at 9  
am Pilot up Capt Allen came on board with the  
Pilot and got under way with a westerly wind at 11  
am came in thick fog and came to anchor in 7 fathoms  
off water 1/2 pm fair edark faint light distance 1/2 mile  
got dinner 90

Remarks on board Friday 24

this day light westerly wind and foggy at 11 am Capt  
went on shore with Pilot all hand in flood in getting  
boat and coaling lines latter part light rain from 11  
to 12 at 4 am the fog cleared up at 4 1/2 am went all  
hand and hoist short and made sail at 6 1/2 the Capt  
came on board with the Pilot and got under way

and standing out the bay with all sail set the Bark  
Tropic Bird in site  
Gull in North  
Gull in West

Remarks on board Saturday 25

this day light with from N. by E to S by E and fine weather  
at 3 pm saw land bar 10 distant 10 miles  
and all hand in flood in standing anchor and chain  
to course  
Bark Tropic Bird in site and plenty  
sheeps and schooners in site latter part light  
from S. by E to S all sail set all hands employed  
in getting cutting gear and boat  
Gull in 40 W  
Gull in 30-36 W

Remarks on board Sunday 26

this day light air and fine weather from  
South all sail set and all hands employed  
in getting cutting gear on bark Tropic  
Bird in site at 4 pm past the ship heading westward  
Pilot boat in sight and two schooners  
latter part light wind South and fine weather  
heading Eastward  
Gull in 40 W  
Gull in 69 W

Remarks on board Monday 27

this day commences with light wind from South  
to S by E fine weather at 5 pm saw black fish young  
quick at 7 the Bark Tropic Bird standing westward
