Friday Oct 10<sup>th</sup> begins with  
fair weather fresh breeze from about  
SSE Steered SE under double reefed top  
sails watch employed working in the rigging  
during the night no sailing weather all  
night Robert the Cook told this fore  
noon saw nothing so ends the day

Lat 39.22 Long 54.34  
Saturday Oct 11<sup>th</sup> begins with  
strong breeze from about West Steered  
ESE saw nothing watch employed variously  
fine weather all night and all day  
so ends the day Lat 38.22 Long 57.33

Sunday Oct 12<sup>th</sup> begins with  
fine weather light breeze from SSW  
steered SE by East saw nothing rainy  
weather all night and all the forenoon  
wind from NW this fore noon no  
observation so ends the day

Monday Oct 13<sup>th</sup> begins with  
better weather good breeze from NNE  
steered SSW watch employed working  
in the rigging no wind from NE this  
forenoon saw one Chimney so ends the day  
Lat 36.36 Long 55.37

Tuesday Oct 14<sup>th</sup> begins with  
fine weather good breeze from NE  
steered SE by South watch employed  
putting on chafing gear on the rigging  
light breeze from SSW this fore  
noon saw nothing but one Seal  
so ends the day Lat 35 Long 50

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Wednesday Oct 15<sup>th</sup> begins with  
pleasant weather light breeze from  
SSW Steered SE by South the  
watch employed variously variable winds  
latter part with rain saw nothing  
so ends the day no obs

Thursday Oct 16<sup>th</sup> begins with  
fresh breeze from South with some  
rain Steered by the wind on the  
Forehead till 4 PM and wore  
Ship Squally and rainy latter part saw  
nothing watch employed variously  
so ends the day Lat 36.00 Long 52.25

Friday Oct 17<sup>th</sup> begins with  
fresh breeze from South by West Steered  
ESE under easy sail saw one sail watch  
employed at incidental duty rainy  
weather latter part saw one Sail so ends  
Lat 36.01 Long 49.50

Saturday Oct 18<sup>th</sup> begins with  
fair weather good breeze from West  
steered ESE watch employed in the  
rigging and getting the Kutting Stage  
ready had the wind from NE  
latter part the day so ends Lat 35.34 Long 47.17

Sunday Oct 19<sup>th</sup> begins with  
fair weather and fresh breeze from  
NE Steered SE under all sail saw  
Blackfish at 2 PM handed the  
light sails at dark rough weather all  
the latter part the day so ends the day  
Lat 34.10 no Long
