Sunday Nov 12th

Begin with heavy Gale from West, with
with dangerous sea running. Ship Hoist
under Storm sail. Middle & latter parts the
same. At 7 A.M. Kept off Steering E by S
This morning the Capt, on going to wind
the Chronometer, discovered that she but
one of the two, had stopped running, cause
unknown. Lat 35 43 Long 61 00

Monday Nov 13th

Begin with Gale from West, with heavy Squalls
& Sea on, Steering E by S. At dark, blowing hard
Have too, heading N. N. W. Middle part wind the
same, with plenty of Rain. Latter part, weather
rather better, Kept off S. E. Lat 35 05 Long 60 00

Tuesday Nov 14th

Begin with Gale from N. N. W. with heavy
squalls & Sea. Ship under Storm sail Steering
E. S. Middle & latter the same. No Ob.

Wednesday Nov 15th

Begin with Moderate Gale from N. N. W.
& Squally weather. Ship under reefed topsails
& Fore Course, Steering E by S. Latter part, the
wind Moderated to light breeze & fine weather
Made all sail Steering E by S. All Hands busy
at work. Lashed the Cutting Pendant to
the Mast Head. So Ob.

Thursday Nov 16th

Begin with light breeze from N. W. with good
weather. Ship under all sail Steering E by S
Middle & latter parts the same
Lat 34 05 Long 52.30

Friday Nov 17th

Begin with strong breeze from N. W. with squally
weather. At dark took in light sails. Middle & latter
Gale from N. W. with Rainy weather, Steering N. W.
under topsails & Courses
No Ob.

Crossing the North Atlantic Nov 1871

Saturday Nov 18th

Begin with Gale from S. W. with thick
foggy weather. At dark shortened sail to
close reefed Main topsail & Fore Course, Middle
& latter parts Moderate Gale from S. W. Made
Lam sail. Steering E by S. Lat 35 20 Long 45.30

Sunday Nov 19th

Begin with Moderate Gale from W. S. W. and
Squally weather. Ship under short sail. Middle
& latter parts Moderate, with good weather
Made all sail Steering E. S. E. Lat 34.51 Long 42.51

Monday Nov 20th

Begin with Moderate breeze from West, with fine
weather. Ship under all sail. Steering E by E
Middle part, the wind hauled to East, with
light breeze & Rainy weather, Ship on the Northern
tack with all sail set, latter part the same

Tuesday Nov 21st

Begin with light winds from East, with
windy Rainy weather, Ship under all sail
heading N. N. E. Middle & latter parts wind and
weather the same. Ship on different tack
No Ob.

Wednesday Nov 22nd

Begin with light winds from East, with
Rainy weather. Ship under all sail, working
to windward. Middle part, the wind hauled
to North, weather the same, Course E. S. E.
Latter part light breeze from N. W. with good weather
but cloudy, No Ob.

Thursday Nov 23rd

Begin with light breeze from N. W. with showery
weather. Ship under all sail Steering E. S. E.
Finished, Cutting Stays & put it out. Middle part
the wind hauled to S. W. with fine breeze & good
weather, latter part same
Lat 35-15 Long 37-49
