subscribed the oath required by law, and having sworn  
that he together with Walter S. Osborn <sup>16</sup>/<sub>10</sub> of Edgartown

only Owners of the vessel called the *Mary Thayer*,  
of Edgartown, whereof Joshua S. Lapham is at  
present Master, and as he hath sworn, is a citizen  
of the United States, and that the said vessel was built  
at Newbury, state of Massachusetts in the year  
1832, as appears by Register No. 1, issued at Edgartown  
May 7, 1887, <sup>surely</sup> property ship'd in part.

And said Register having certified that the said vessel  
has two decks and three masts, and that her length  
is 113 <sup>8</sup>/<sub>10</sub> feet; her breadth 25 <sup>0</sup>/<sub>10</sub> feet; her depth  
15 <sup>8</sup>/<sub>10</sub> feet; her height <sup>0</sup>/<sub>10</sub> feet; and that she measures  
286 and <sup>35</sup>/<sub>100</sub> tons viz:
