Sunday October 23 - 1859

steering by the wind on the starboard tack
light winds with fog. raised sperm whales
Abington ahead Albermarl on the weather quarter
got one whale after taking two lines

Monday at daylight called all hands
and commenced cutting at five o'clock
at night got it on deck

Tuesday October 25 - 1859

at daylight spoke the same 2 whales alongside and
2 boats off just to a whale - Picked up a dead whale -
and cut him in

Sunday October 30 - 1859
at daylight heading in for lee bow: 3 said in sight
saw finbacks and Blackfish, at night between
Rounder rock and N.E. Point steering to the N.E. of

Monday October 31 - 1859 N.E. Point on the weather

beam: Abington ahead. Coasting and stowing
oil in the fore hold: saw finbacks and Porpoises
