Wednesday November 2 - 1859 -
 at daylight Abbermar on the weather bow. Round
 rock on the lee bow. Wore ship to the eastward -
 coopersing and stowing down oil in the fore hold
 at night no land in sight. Wore ship to the westward

Thursday November 3 - 1859 - steering by the
 wind to the eastward. Got through stowing down
 oil and washed ship. Saw the ship Joseph
 Meigs bound to the westward. at night wore
 ship to the westward

Friday November 4 - 1859
 Steering by the wind to the eastward. Coopersing
 repairing the waist boat. Coopers making over
 Cask

Saturday November 5 - 1859
 steering by the wind to the eastward. the Coopers
 making over shoes
