and heading East and several at 12  
run down heading S. W. D. employed  
in repairing S. B. O. D. M. G. heading  
S. W. D. latter blowing fresh from S. S. E.  
heading S. S. W. D. finished repairing B. O.

Friday Mar 10<sup>th</sup> Lat 36° 18' Lon 75° 51'  
Wind fresh blowing fresh from S. S. E.  
heading S. E. and Middle D. latter the same

Saturday Mar 11<sup>th</sup> Lat 36° 33' Lon 73° 54'  
Wind fresh strong breeze from S. S. E.  
steering S. D. at 2 P.M. reef main  
top sail field the main sail at 7 P.M.  
made the light B. E. K. bearing  
E by N dist 12 miles more ship to  
the west very moderate. middle part  
the same at 12 midnight  
rose ship to the east at 3 P.M.  
steered in to the bay got cables  
up and got ready to anchor  
at 1 P.M. came to anchor at  
Tolehuano in 5 fathoms water  
55 fathoms claim field sails  
and fine wind from the south  
this day end with 36 hours end sea time

Sunday March 12<sup>th</sup>  
begins fine winds from the south  
and clear weather all through the day

Monday <sup>13<sup>th</sup></sup> comes with fine  
winds from the south and fine weather  
employed in waiting ship out side  
and other jobs about ship so ends

Tuesday March 14<sup>th</sup>  
Comences with mild from the south and  
fine weather employed in breaking out  
oil the fore hatch later part strong  
wind from the south and foggy and the same

Wed March 15<sup>th</sup>  
light winds from the south and pleasant  
employed cooper oil and backing cask  
got the slush out of the hole  
on deck middle part curd the same

Thursday March 16<sup>th</sup> light winds from the  
north sent 100 lbs oil whale oil ashore  
and 5' oil struck ashore out the  
after hole and winds strong from the North  
middle and later part rain

Friday March 17<sup>th</sup>  
Comences with from the south and  
light fogs and some rain used  
the after hole ship bare and other stuff  
used off deck ship sold so ends

Saturday March 18<sup>th</sup>  
wind from the north and rain  
middle and later part fine and  
pleasant the cruas temp all went  
ashore and pleasant weather
