A journal of a whaling voyage on board
of Bark *Northport* of Westport, which sailed
from Westport April the 23rd 1869 Capt
Walter Smith Master

Remark on board April the 23rd 1869
got under way and ran out side and
came of anchor waiting for the captain
and part of the crew to come this day

Remark on board April the 24th

At one o'clock P.M. all hands come on board
and stood to sea had the wind from the south
west later had strong breeze to wind this day

Remarks on board Sunday April the 25th

Commenced with strong breeze and rapid weather
heading to the southward and eastward all of this day
four hours to windward this day

Remarks on board Monday April the 26th

Commenced with a moderate gale and rapid
weather heading to the southward and eastward
later had much the same blowing strong to windward

Remark on board Tuesday April the 27th

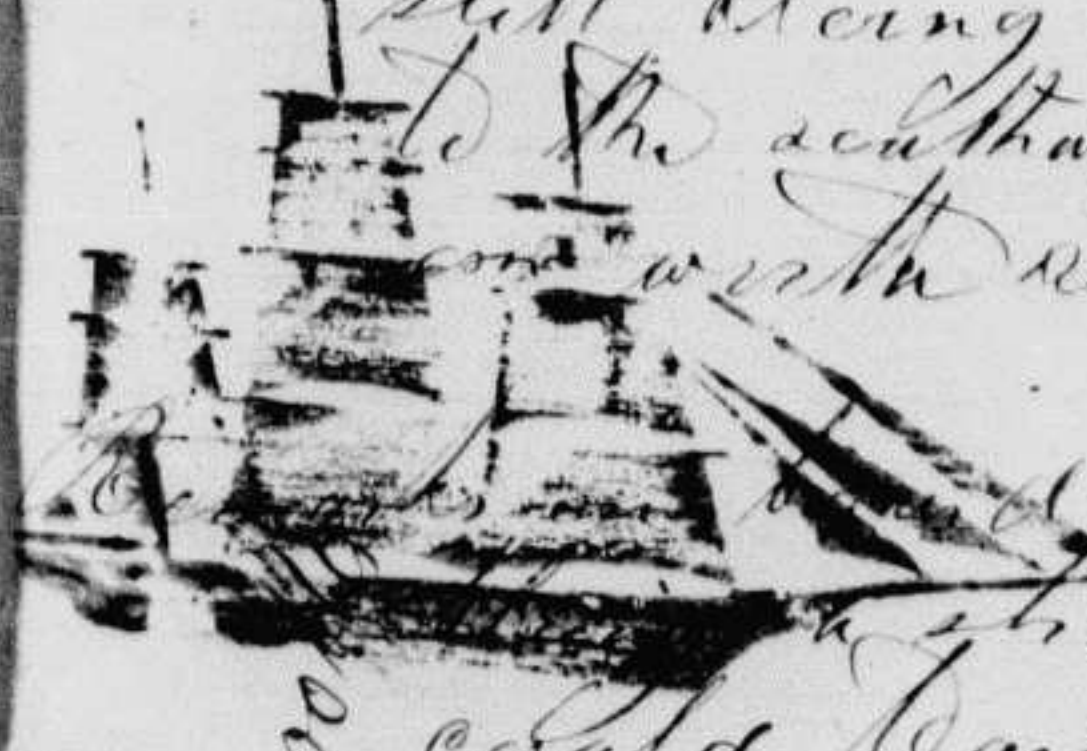
still blowing a gale from the westward standing
to the southward under short sail making good
way with remark to windward this day

Wednesday April the 28th

still blowing a gale from the westward and rapid
weather heading to the southward and eastward
later had much the same blowing strong to windward

Remarks on board Thursday April the 29th

still blowing a gale from the westward and rapid
weather heading southward all this day to windward
