

Remarks on board Saturday October the 15<sup>th</sup> 1840

Commenced with fresh breezes from south east and fair weather at sundown took in the light sail middle and latter part fresh breezes steering out so ends Lat 31.52 Long 49.38

Remarks on board Sunday October the 16<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with fresh breezes from south east and raged within at sundown took in the light sail middle and latter part fine breezes steering north west so ends Lat 31.49 Long 51.38

Remarks on board Monday October the 17<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with fine breezes from east and fair weather middle and latter part fine breezes steering north west so ends Lat 32.48 Long 52.38

Remarks on board Tuesday October the 18<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with fresh breezes from the east and fair weather middle and latter part much the same steering out by north so ends Lat 32.52 Long 53.47

Remarks on board Wednesday October the 19<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with fine breezes from south east and fair weather at three o'clock the wind shifted south west by west ship heading to the north west and westward latter part strong breezes so ends Lat 33.11 Long 57.32

Remarks on board Thursday October the 20<sup>th</sup> 1840

Commenced with strong breezes and squally weather at six o'clock half watches middle and latter part light breezes heading west by south so ends Lat 33.20 Long 58.36

Remarks on board Friday October the 21<sup>st</sup>

Commenced with light breezes from the south and fair weather middle and latter part strong breezes heading to the westward so ends Lat 32.49 Long 61.14

Remarks on board Saturday October the 22<sup>nd</sup>

Commenced with strong breezes from the south and raged within at sundown took in the light sails saw a brig steering to the west middle and latter part fresh breezes so ends Lat 32.06 Long 68.13

Remarks on board Sunday October the 23<sup>rd</sup>

Commenced with fresh breezes and fair weather at sundown had it calm and thick weather at seven got a breeze from north east latter part blowing a gale from Birmosa at nine at six o'clock steering out west by west Lat 32.10 Long 55.30

Remarks on board Monday October the 24<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with a gale from north east and raged within at sundown parted the fore top sail and kept to the wind at one o'clock at the fore top sail and steered north west by west latter part blowing strong so ends Lat 33.17 Long 67.59
