

Remarks on board Tuesday October the 25<sup>th</sup> 1870

Comment with moderate gails from north east and raged within middle and latter part more moderate set all sail so was fast 24.22 Long 10.29

Remarks on board Wednesday October the 26<sup>th</sup>

Comment with fine breezes from the east and fair weather at six AM the wind hauled north west latter part light breezes saw a ship to the north so was fast 24.30 Long 11.28

Remarks on board Thursday October the 27<sup>th</sup>



Comment with light breezes from north west and fair weather at two o'clock PM raised spinn whales heard for them the sail had got mast in and for a while saw the boat and put down and then they went eyes out it came on board and stood on the the westward middle and latter part strong breezes bearing north west so was fast 25.15 Long 11.17

Remarks on board Friday October the 28<sup>th</sup>

Comment with moderate breezes from north east and raged within at twelve PM the wind shifted to the east and blewed strong still steering north west by north latter part strong breezes so was fast 26.17 Long 12.27

Remarks on board Saturday October the 29<sup>th</sup>

Comment with strong breezes from the west and raged within four sails at sundown had it calm at twelve PM blowed strong and that with the reef down it ranise clear off Coast strong latter part strong breezes so was fast 26.58 Long 13.52

Remarks on board Sunday October the 30<sup>th</sup> 1870

Comment with strong breezes from north north west and raged within ship heading to the west saw a number of sails middle and latter part light breezes heading to the north so was fast 28.08 Long 13.08

Remarks on board Monday October the 31<sup>st</sup>

Comment with light breezes from the east and fair weather at sundown took in the light sails wind hauled up strong and within lashed top and back latter part of the night hauled in the main top sail took in all sail but the main topsail and read before the wind at daylight took in the main topsail and hove two latter part the wind hauled to the west and blew strong ship heading to the north so was fast 28.08 Long 13.08

Remarks on board Tuesday November the 1<sup>st</sup>

Comment with a gail from west north west and raged within set the main top sail and fore gail and steered north north east at sundown took in the fore sail and took it in light through the night at daylight repaired the fore sail and set it again latter part more moderate set the fore top sail and gail and main sail so was steering to the north so was fast 40.20 Long 12.10

Remarks on board Wednesday November the 2<sup>nd</sup>

Comment with strong breezes from the westward and raged within at three o'clock PM saw a land at ten PM part Montserrat at ten AM got down off west part and anchored in side of the low mild rock so was this day

Remarks on board Thursday November the 3<sup>rd</sup>, 1870

Comment with fair weather at three PM got under way and came in to the harbor so was an unsteady breeze in the old Park Montserrat
