Tuesday 8th

Commences today with light variable
airs & calms vessel steering W. N. W.
when she can. crew employed on
ships duty Middle part a moderate breeze
from the S. S. W. vessel steering W.
N. W. Latter part a strong breeze from
the same quarter so ends this day.

Wednesday 9th

Commences today with a strong breeze
from the S. S. W. with pleasant weather
vessel steering W. by N. bound for
America saw one sail Middle &
Latter part wind and weather the same
with the exception of a few rain squalls
saw nothing so ends this day

Thursday 10th

Commences today with a strong
breeze from the S. W. with fine weather
vessel by the wind on the Port tack
bound home crew employed on ships
duty Middle & Latter parts the wind
from the Northward vessel steering
West saw nothing but plenty of small
fish around the vessel so ends this
day

Friday 11th

Commences today with a moderate
but variable winds from the West-
ward with pleasant weather vessel
by the wind on the Starboard tack
heading sometimes S. W. other times
W. S. W. crew employed on ships
duty Middle & Latter parts the
wind & weather the same so ends
this day

Saturday 12th

Commences today with a very
strong breeze from the W. S. W.
with cloudy weather vessel by the
wind on the Port tack heading
N. W. reefed the topsails & took in
the light sail on account of a N
W. swell being dead a head Middle

part the wind shifted into the N. E. W.
Latter part a strong breeze from the
same quarter saw nothing so ends this
day

Sunday 13th

Commences today with a strong breeze
from the N. E. W. with pleasant
weather vessel on her course close
to the wind on the Starboard tack
crew employed on ships duty Middle
& Latter parts a strong breeze from the
N. E. with heavy rain squalls saw
nothing so ends this day

Monday 14th

Commences today with a strong
breeze from the N. E. with heavy
rain squalls vessel steering N. E.
bound for New Bedford crew
employed on ships duty Middle
part blowing very strong from the N
E. Latter part a more moderate
breeze from the same quarter saw
one sail so ends this day

Tuesday 15th

Commences today with a moderate
breeze from the N. E. with pleasant
weather vessel steering W. N. W.
crew employed on ships duty saw
three sails Middle & Latter parts
the wind & weather the same saw one
sail bound to the West Indies so ends
this day

Wednesday 16th

Commences today with a moderate breeze
from the N. E. with pleasant weather
vessel steering N. W. close hauled to the
wind crew employed scraping down the
masts & on ships duty Middle & Latter
parts a very light breeze from the E.
saw nothing so ends this day
