from S. S. E. ship steering S. E under all sail
at 3. 30 P. M. passed. Remains of a wreck. Middle
and latter part strong breeze and squalls with
rain from S. S. W. to W. S. W. ship steering S. E.
under all prudent sail. hands employed doing
ships duty. so ends. Latt at Noon 33. 16

Thursday Nov 6th Long " " 51. 47

Commences with fresh breeze from S. W.
with cloudy weather ship steering S. E. under
all sail. Middle part moderate breeze from W. S. W.
latter part strong breeze from N. N. E. ship steering
S. E. under all sail. hands employed doing ships
duty. so ends. Latt at Noon

Friday Nov 7th Long " " 47. 55 W

Commences with strong breeze from N. N. E.
ship steering S. E. under all sail. Middle part fresh
breeze from N. E. latter part moderate breeze from
E. N. E. ship steering S. E. under all sail. hands
employed. rigging cutting stage, and ships duty
so ends. Latt at Noon 30. 36 N

Saturday Nov 8th Long " " 47. 55 W

Commences with moderate breeze
from E. to E. S. E. ship steering by the wind to
the S. + S. E ward under all sail. Middle part
fresh breeze from E. to S. E. Latter part strong breeze

ship by the wind up to S. E. under all prudent
sail hands employed doing ships duty
so ends.

Sunday Nov 9th

Commences with strong breeze from
S. W. ship steering S. E. to S. E. by S under

heavy rain + thunder from S. W. to W. Ship
steering S. E. under all prudent sail latter part
light winds from S. W. ship steering S. E.
under all sail. so ends Latt 28. 46 N

Monday Nov 10th

Commences with light winds with
rain from S. S. W. Ship steering S. E. Middle
part fresh breeze with thunder squalls + rain
from S. W. ship steering S. E. to S. E. under
all prudent sail latter part the same. hands
employed on ships duty so ends Latt at Noon 28. 12

Tuesday Nov 11th

Commences with fresh breeze with
rain squalls from S. S. W. ship steering S. E.
Middle part the same. latter part moderate breeze
from N. W. ship steering S. S. E. under all sail
hands employed on ships duty. Latt at noon 27. 19. 20

Long " " 42. 20 W

Wednesday Nov 12th

Commences with light winds from N. W.
with pleasant weather ship steering S. S. E. under
all sail. Middle + latter parts light airs + calms
ship working to the S. S. E. this day saw several
finbacks. hands employed on ships duty so ends
Latt by DR 27. 05

Thursday Nov 13th Long " " 41. 57

Commences with calms. and light
airs from N. W. ship steering S. S. E. under all sail.
Middle + latter parts light winds from N. to N. E. ship
steering S. E. by S under all sail hands employed
on ships duty. so ends Latt by Obs 26. 24
