

Tuesday
the 18th
May

This Day commenced with squalls
of rain and wind at 12 the wind got
regular continued blowing from
the E. N. E. all day watch employed
in fitting the rigging and the other
below courses steamed on N. W. 1/2 S
Latitude at 12 was 15° 25' South

Wednesday
the 19th
May

This Day commenced with strong Trades
from the N. E. and courses N. W. 1/2 S
all hands employed in Tanning the
Rigging at 6 o'clock finished and cleared
the Decks so ends this Day Latitude
at 12 was 17° 44' South

Thursday
the 20th
May

This Day commenced with gentle Gale
at E. S. E. & courses N. W. all hands emp
loyed in ships duty at 2 in the after
noon the wind began to breeze at
6 a strong breeze and sheaves to come
nothing seen this Day so ends the Day
Latitude at 12 was 19° 25' South

Friday
the 21st
May

This Day commenced with gentle
Gale from the N. E. and Cherry sweet
from the East courses N. W. all hands
employed in painting the spars
yards mast and blocks at 6 finished
so ends this Day saw a Sparrow Hawk
fly to the East Latitude at 12 was
21° 11' South

Saturday
the 22nd
May

This Day commenced with light winds
and showers of rain all hands employed
in ships duty at 11 started back at
12 in the afternoon saw 20 sails to the
West

Saturday
the 22nd
May

Saw an immense quantity of Gull weed
our courses N. W. wind S. W. to ends this Day
Latitude at 12 was 22° 25' South

Sunday
the 23rd
May

This Day commenced with gentle breeze
from S. W. and courses N. W. nothing going
on this Day at all. Pleasant weather all Day
Saw large quantity of Gull weed so
ends this Day Latitude at 12 was 23° 31' S

Monday
the 24th
May

This Day commenced with thick cloudy
weather and a gentle breeze from the East
at 6 courses N. W. at 9 in the morning
became fine weather all hands employed
in ships duty in the afternoon began
to square the Ratlines in the lower rigging
at 6 finished and cleared the Decks so
ends this Day Latitude at 12 was 25° 31' S

Tuesday
the 25th
May

This Day commenced with gentle Gale
from the S. W. and courses N. W. all hands
employed in painting the inside of the
Ship at 6 finished all but the
rails on top continued fine weather
all the Day so ends Latitude at 12
was 26° 48' South

Wednesday
the 26th
May

This Day commenced with strong winds
and thick rainy weather at 6 in the
afternoon the wind hauled to the West
courses N. W. and blew hard in the
afternoon watch blown and the rest employed
to ends this Day so ends Latitude at 12

Thursday
the 27th
May

This Day commenced with S. W. air winds and
showers of rain continued so till 4 in
the afternoon and then clear and
with the east wind in the evening
