All of these 24 hours fine
weather employed in fitting
the Boats At 10 Am Capt
Cook light bore S to by NW
Dist 15 miles saw many
blackfish and porpoises

on Board of Brig Medford of Provincetown Harvey =
Cook. Master

Monday August the 24th

All of these 24 hours light
winds attended with rain and
fog & steering S by E

Long by Account 68 45 W

Tuesday August the 25th

All of these 24 hours strong
winds and squally At 10
Am Double reefed the sails
& steering S by E sun rain
