

Ship Head Round towards the Cape  
Thursday Nov 22<sup>nd</sup> 1849  
at 12 got all hands on Board & took the  
steer out of the Bay at 1 o'clock  
to let wind from the North all hands  
in stowing the masts & Middle Part fine  
weather stowing 1st all sail set latter Part  
wind at West & fine weather all hands  
in filling the Boats & other jobs So Ends  
Latt by ob 39-57  
1. {The time seems long} Long by thro 40-157

Friday Nov 23<sup>rd</sup> 1849  
First part fine weather wind at West stowing 1st  
all sail set Middle Part fine weather all  
sail set latter Part the same saw at 11  
stowing Northward saw at 12  
So Ends  
Latt by ob 38-47  
2. {When I think of it} Long by thro 39-19

Saturday Nov 24<sup>th</sup> 1849  
First part calm with fine weather all hands  
employed Middle Part light air attended with  
cup for latter Part the same with sail set  
So Ends  
Latt by ob 39-50  
3. {It does} Long by thro 39-40

Sunday Nov 25<sup>th</sup> 1849  
First part light breeze from the North stowing 1st  
all sail set saw at 11 ship stowing Southward  
Middle Part at 1 saw at 11 ship stowing  
at 9 took in 1st & 2nd & kept the 3rd sail latter  
part moderate set all sail with Battering  
So Ends  
Latt by ob 39-18  
4. {Gentle} Long by thro 38-30

Monday Nov 26<sup>th</sup> 1849  
First part light air & Battering weather fine  
went at 9 took in beer from the 1st heading  
Top of sails at 1 wind at West stowing 1st  
latter part moderate weather  
So Ends  
Latt by ob 39-18  
Long by thro 38-30
