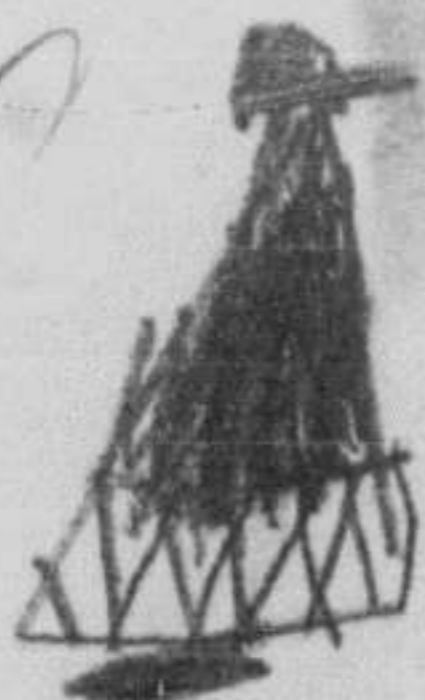

# A Journal on A Whale Cruise 1881

Friday June the 17th At 10 AM got under  
weigh from Newport And And At 4 AM  
Block Island Bearing West the distance 10  
miles from which I take my departure And  
At 8 took in the fore and main topgallant sail  
And reef the fore and main topsail with main  
And tinnier And At 7 wore ship and stood  
to the Eastward And made sail several  
sail in sight so End these 24 Hours  
Lat 40 58 Long 71 44

Saturday June the 18th these 24 Hours  
Begin with light winds from S S W  
And At 4 PM saw two sail to the windward  
And At 10 come in foggy so End these 24  
Hours Lat by D R 40 16 Long 70 33 - -

Sunday June the 19th these 24 Hours Begins  
with light winds from N S W and At 4 AM  
broke out the hole And got water And At  
4 Caught a porpoise And At 10 AM saw two sail  
S S W and At 10 the Starboard Boat caught a Black fish  
so End these 24 Hours Lat by D R 39 23 Long 68 50
