For southern seas we are bound
With winds both fresh and free

Diegos, Alfonsos - Evvots - Staten Land - Cape Horn
Tower Rock - Jarvis - Gilberts Rocks - Landfall Island
Francs Island - N Point - Inuges or Apostles - Allis Point
Magellan Harbour three miles due north
Evangelists & Sevels Rocks - Duncan Rocks
Harbour E N E 2 1/2 miles distant. Middle Rock
through Deception Straits - West Channel
Lons harbour within 1/2 mile

The above named localities in the vicinity of
Cape Horn was formerly favourite haunts of
the fur seal. At least, its the testimony of old
voyagers around Terra Del Fuage and Magellan
straits, Patagonia & Staten Land

- July 22^d left Stonington bound for the south seas.
Pleasant and fine weather throughout the day
July 23^d Fair and pleasant breezes. Lat in 39.46 Long 69.08
July 24^d Fair pleasant winds westerly. Lat 39.00 Lon 68.02 W
July 25th Fresh and fair breezes yet. Lat in 38.34 Lon 68.02 W
July 26th Moderate with considerable sea. Lat 38.34 Lon 67.20 W
July 27th Sunday. Mild and pleasant this day 38.47 Lon 66.14 W
July 28th Fair weather all this 24 hours. 38.34 Lon 65.01 W
July 29th Pleasant, all day with mist 38.49 Lon 64.49 W
July 30th Strong breezes and squally. 38.33 Lon 64.01 W
July 31st Light babbling winds from the
eastern board 37.68 Lon 63.37 W
