Wednesday 28th Sep. 1836.

Commenced working all day on deck making
sails at 10 O'clock saw the Island St. Antonio
at 4 O'clock lowered the Larboard boat and
sent her ashore with a sick man.

Thursday 29th

Fine weather wind from the N.E. all possible
sail set. fair weather throughout this day

Friday 30th

Fine Pleasant weather and Moderate breezes
throughout the day.

Saturday 1st Oct^r 1836.

First part fine weather wind from the
Northward & Eastward

Latter part Squally with some showers
of rain this day Employ'd making an
Oil Tunnel for the ship use,
