

Sunday 2nd Oct^r

This morning lost the draw Bucket
over board Fine weather with light airs
from the Southward & Westward course S.S.E.
Middle and Latter part much the same

Lat. by Obs. 10 37 N.

Monday 3rd Oct^r

Commenced with light airs and variable attended
with rain Middle part clear and Extreme warm
Two sail in sight off the Starboard beam
Standing the same as us this day made a
Draw Bucket,

Lat by Obs. 9. 54 N.

Tuesday 4th Oct^r

This day commences with fine Pleasant
weather the wind from the Southward and
Westward Middle and Latter part as above,
This day Employ'd fitting a Beck Iron and
various other jobs.

Lat at Noon 9. 23 N.

Wednesday 5th October

Commences with fresh breezes from N.E.W. a
Ship in sight off the weather bow
Middle and Latter part some little rain
Wind from S.W. killed a goat for the People
forward at 7 o'clock this Evening caught a
Porpoise,

Lat at Noon 7. 52 N.

Thursday 6th October

Fresh breezes from the Southward and
Westward Middle part Squally with heavy
Showers of rain Latter part Moderate
and clear weather This day Employ'd
Making a Saw Tub

Friday 7th

Fine Pleasant weather all possible
Sail set a Ship off the Lee bow standing
to the Southward Middle and Latter part
Moderate and clear weather this day
variously Employ'd

Latitude at Noon 4. 44 N.

Saturday 8th

This day commences with cloudy
weather light breeze and variable attended
with a little rain, broke out in the main
hatch for old shooks and heading
Middle part as above Latter part of this day
fresh breezes from the Southward and Eastward
No Observation

Sunday 9th

First part fresh breezes from S.W. all
possible sail set at 8 o'clock a sail in sight
off the weather beam Middle and latter
part as above at 6 o'clock the above sail hoisted
Portugues colours then off the leeward Lat at noon 2. 25 N.
