

Remarks Saturday 30th December 1837-

This morning Moderate weather at noon
saw Whales off our lee bow lowered the
Starboard and Mast boats took one
each I supposed the two to make 70 barrels
and have 26 barrels on hand, saw a Ship
Sap to windward of us, supposed her to
be the Henry. Latitude at noon 13. 3. S.

Sunday 31st

This day put in the two Whales and
lowered three times for whales this day
but no success. Started three 60 of Flour
and fitted them for oil fine weather
throughout this day,

Monday 1st January 1838,

This day boiling Started three 60 of
Flour one of Corn one Water Cask and
the Bread Cask on board started a
barrel of beef fitted the whole for oil
two sail in sight off the lee quarter

Tuesday 2nd

This morning started a Cask of Shook
heads marked N. one 60 of Water and
four of Flour and triced them for oil
Finished boiling at noon,

Remarks Wednesday 3rd January 1838,
This Morning moderate weather took a
bad head out of a Cask of oil marked
J. N. 9. put in a good old head the
remainder part of the day Employ'd
making rice, two 60 on hand fitted for oil
Thursday 4th

This day put two new heads in a Water
60 and made a bot frame for M^r. J.
Randolph Employ'd making rice
two sail in sight off our lee bow at
sun set tack'd headed to the Westward
Friday 5th

This day myself and Randolph
making rice fine Pleasant weather
throughout the day,

Saturday 6th

This morning fine moderate weather
boop'd four barrels and fifteen runs
of oil ready for stowing, Shook a
Water Cask one of the ground tier
used the hoops of it on the oil Randolph
Employ'd as yesterday, latter part of
this day Strong breeze

Sunday 7th

Fine weather throughout this day
