

Journal of a Voyage in the Ship

Nov: 14th 1841

At 7 o'clock weigh anchor abreast of Clandon Point, wind N.W. at 4 P.M. sea bett Roman Lana bore N by E. Distance 16 Miles from which I take my Departure winds variable untill 6 A.M. then hauld to the N.W. Course S.E. Latitude at noon 40. 23 N

Nov: 16th Long. -- 68. 10 W

This day commences with Strong breezes at A.M. Course S.E. at 3 P.M. took in the main top Gallant sail at 6 P.M. double Reef'd Fore & main top sails and furled the Mizzen, topsail, Middle and Latter part Strong breezes and Spying Showers of Rain, Latitude 39. 00 -

Nov: 17th

First part Strong breeze and hard Squalls and Rain at 7 P.M. Close Reef'd Fore topsail at midnight close Reef'd the main. at 3 A.M. furled the Fore topsail Latter part Strong breezes and hard Squalls

Long 62. 15 W.

Nov: 18th Henry of Fair-haven to the P. Ocean

The First part Weather more Moderate at 9 P.M. Increasing breeze and Rain attended with Thunder and Lightning at 6 A.M. Weather more Moderate set Fore top sail out one Reef of the main Latter part fine Weather, out all Reef-Set main top Gallant sail

Nov: 19th

This day commences with fine Weather at 2 P.M. Longitude 72 Lunar 58. at 9 P.M. took in the main top Gallant sail at 1 A.M. double reef'd Fore and main Topsails furled the Mizzen. do. Latter part Moderate Weather

Lat 37. 13. N

Long 55. 05 W.

Nov: 20th

Commences with Fair Weather but a heavy swell wind N.W. Course S.E. by E Middle part Strong breeze attended with Squalls at 6 A.M. out Reef'd Fore and main Topsails set the Mizzen Fine Weather throughout

Lat 36. 32 N.

Long 52. 41 W.
