

Remarks Saturday, 27<sup>th</sup> Nov. 1841.

This day commences with Rain and light breezes from N.W.E. Course S.E. by S.

Middle and Latter part light breezes and Variable. Latitude by Obs. 33. 30 N. Longitude by Acct. 34. 08 W.

Sunday 28<sup>th</sup>

Moderate and Clear Weather Course S.S.E. Winds N.W. at 7 a.m. set the Studding sails Latter part fine weather and Steady breezes. Latitude by Obs. 32. 32 N.

Monday 29<sup>th</sup>

Fine clear weather steering S.S.E. Winds S.W. by W. Middle part strong breezes took in lower Studding sail, at 6 a.m. broke out and started Water Latter part fine weather saw a sail off the Weather bow. Latitude by Obs. 30. 46 N.

Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup>

First part of this 24 hours Moderate and Clear Course south winds West Northwesterly, middle part Fair weather at day light saw a Boat off the Weather beam, supposed her to be the same we seen yesterday Latter part fair at 8 a.m. sent the main Royal aloft. Lat 28. 19 N.

Remarks Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> Dec. 1841

This day commences with fine weather Rigged out the Flying jib boom and sent the sail Middle and Latter part light breezes from the Northward Course South. Latitude 27. 13 N. Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup>

Fine Moderate weather all drawing sail set Steering south winds West and light breezes, all day on deck Employ'd making Molasses Keys for the People Middle and Latter part as above. Latitude 26. 12 N.

Friday 3<sup>rd</sup>

Fine weather and light breezes course S.S.W. Winds W by N. Middle part calm Latter part light breezes from the Southward & Eastward heave S.W. Carpenter Employ'd caulking waterway seams. Latitude 25. 38 N.

Saturday 4<sup>th</sup>

Light breezes and Variable throughout these 24 hours - Latitude 24. 41 N.

Sunday 5<sup>th</sup>

This day commences with a light breeze and clear weather Middle and Latter part very light and Variable Long. of Lunar, 27. 40 Lat 23. 55 N.
