

Remarks Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> May 1844  
Some moderate weather stored down about 80 bbls  
of oil in the after hold,

Sunday 19<sup>th</sup>  
Strong breeze and Cloudy Weather No Obs.

Monday 20<sup>th</sup>  
Moderate breeze and foggy, trim'd three 90, for oil  
and hooked 30 Provisional bbls Lat at noon 29.38

Tuesday 21<sup>st</sup>  
This day let up one Water cask Spoke No 1. 302 gallons  
Spoke the Ship Edward Cary - of Nantucket - 1200 bbls

Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup>  
Strong gales and a heavy swell saw the Cary  
left to windward of us.

Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup>  
This day let up one Spoke No 5. 240 gallons and trim'd  
255 Gallon cask that contains Iron Hoops for oil, Putting  
Hoops of Rain and fog.

Friday 24<sup>th</sup>  
This day made two 13<sup>th</sup> Rigs fine clear Weather this day  
Lat at noon 30.28 N

Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> Long of Lunar at 4 o'clock 157.27 E  
Fine clear Weather and calm the most part of this day  
made one 15<sup>th</sup> Rig Lat 29.58 N

Sunday 26<sup>th</sup>  
This day Rain and foggy Weather No Obs.

Monday 27<sup>th</sup>  
This day made two 15<sup>th</sup> Rigs, Spoke the Three  
Brooked 150 bbls this season Lat at noon 29.52

Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup>  
This day made one 13<sup>th</sup> and one 12<sup>th</sup> Rigs light air  
and foggy some part of this day Lat at noon 29.55 N

Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> Long of Planet Venus and Moon 7 o'clock 157.39 E  
This day made one 12<sup>th</sup> Rig, fine clear Weather two  
sails in sight Lat at noon 30.17 N

Thursday 30<sup>th</sup>  
This day trying to anchor a close by main topsail, No Obs.

Friday 31<sup>st</sup>  
Strong breeze and a heavy swell two sails in sight  
Lat at noon 30.20 N.

Remarks Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> June 1844  
This day made one 13<sup>th</sup> Rig cold and cloudy  
Weather,

Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup>  
Moderate Weather this day Lat at noon 31.12

Monday 3<sup>rd</sup>  
This day favourable weather but cold, made one  
10<sup>th</sup> Rig at 4 o'clock saw Whales, doubt full -  
Lat 31.55 N.

Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup>  
Fine Moderate Weather this day made one 11<sup>th</sup>  
Rig, Lat at noon 32.12 N.

Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup>  
Moderate Weather this day made one 13<sup>th</sup> and  
one 11<sup>th</sup> Rigs. Lat at noon 31.52 N.

Thursday 6<sup>th</sup>  
Moderate and Cloudy Weather made one 10<sup>th</sup>  
Rig Lat at noon 30.59 N.

Friday 7<sup>th</sup>  
Moderate Weather this day, made one 12<sup>th</sup> Rig  
Lat at noon 30.30

Saturday 8<sup>th</sup> Long of Lunar at 11 o'clock 159.4 E  
Light airs and clear Weather, this afternoon lowered for  
Whales, Lat at noon 30.20 N.

Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> Long of Lunar at 9 o'clock 158.17 E  
Calm and clear Weather this day Lat at noon 30.22 N.

Monday 10<sup>th</sup> Long of Lunar at 10 o'clock 158.9 E  
Light breezes this day, made one 12<sup>th</sup> Rig Lat 30.09 N.

Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup>  
Fine clear Weather this day, heard N. Lat 30.5  
made one small Rig

Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup>  
Fine breeze and hazy Weather heading East Lat 31.01

Thursday 13<sup>th</sup>  
Fine Moderate Weather this day Lat 31.09  
Long of Sun - 159.29 E.

Friday 14<sup>th</sup>  
Fine heavy breeze this day heading East Lat 30.57  
Long 161.44 E.

Saturday 15<sup>th</sup>  
Strong gales the most part of this day Lat 31.13 N.

Sunday 16<sup>th</sup>  
Strong gales this day saw two Barges pass to windward of us  
Lat 31.16 N.
