

Remarks On board

Wednesday January 7th 1846

commences with strong breezes from the West coast N East at 7 took in sail till too heading W by N at daylight like wind made sail course N E by East

Lat 35 " 32
Long 164 " 40

Thursday January 8th
commences with like wind at 2 came to East at 3 saw sperm whales loared took one to S Boat took him a side took in sail



at daylight commenced cutting at 10 AM finished cutting made sail steering by S by West wind E by South

Friday January 9th

at 3 P.M. commenced heaving at 7 took in sail wind N East very like

at daylight wind E S East saw porpoises made all sail backed ship to N by East

Ships Koozeyuna

January 10th 1846
Saturday commences with like fine weather wind East coast N at 7 came down took in sail at daylight made all sail to N E by N at like

Lat 34 " 44

Long 164 " 40

Sunday January 11th

commences with a calm at 1 P.M. saw a break a long way off at 8 P.M. took in sail the weather black and windy at 9 raining

at daylight strong breeze at E S East steering by N East saw porpoises

Lat 34 " 24
Long 165 " 39

Monday January 12th

commences with strong breezes at E S East steering N East at 7 took in sail struck and killed a whale from and sunk 2 porpoises

at daylight like winds at E S E at 4 broke broke out after hole stowed down 12 lbs sperm oil at 3 P.M. put a barque bound N West by N at 4 finished stowed off the hole
