 Sunday
 Aug 31st
 At 4 A.M. took our anchor at Nantucket Bar & proceeded
 up sound. Latter part a moderate wind at NE & thick
 rainy weather. so ends this day.

Sunday
 Aug 31st
 Commences with a moderate wind at NE attended
 with squalls of rain & thick weather. at 3 P.M.
 discharged our Pilot at Tappan's Cove, at 6 P.M.
 Kinans Land Rose North, distant 3 Leagues from which
 I take my departure, Middle part B. W. Wind at NE
 & cloudy steering S.P.E. at 6 A.M. kept the ship S.E.
 Latter part Light Wind from the Southward steering as
 above
 Latitude By O.B. 39° 50' N
 Course S.P.E. Dist 88 miles Long By a.C. 69° 56' W

Monday
 Aug 31st
 Commences with a moderate Breeze from the Southward
 steering E.B.P. 9 knots, saw a Schooner,
 Middle & Latter part Calm pleasant weather, employed
 fitting the Boat & craft. Latitude By O.B. 39° 35' N
 Course E.P.E. Dist 35 miles Longitude By a.C. 69° 14' W

Tuesday
 Aug 4th
 Commences with a Light Breeze from the Southward
 & pleasant weather steering sharp By E.B.P. employed
 breaking out the fore hold to get empty casks to
 stow, Middle & Latter part Light Wind at PM &
 pleasant steering E.B.P. 4 knots
 Course E.P.W. Dist 108 miles
 Latitude By O.B. 39° 23' N
 Follow 24 miles & Current to the day Long By a.C. 66° 55' W

Wednesday
 Aug 5th
 Commences with a Light Wind at PM & pleasant
 steering E.B.P.
 Middle part much the same
 Latter part a fine Breeze at PM & cloudy steering
 E.B.P. 4 knots
 Latitude By O.B. 40° 11' N
 Course E.B.W. Dist 135 miles
 Long By a.C. 64° 03' W
 Long By Chron 62° 56' W
