Left Pernambuco March the 10th 1838 for the Coast of Chile

March the 14th saw a Sperm, Lat 18.00 S Long 75.53 W
March the 21st got a Sperm Whale, Lat 22.40 S. the Sun in sight
April the 7th struck 2 Sperm Whales got ones, Lat 26.10 S. Long 43.20 W
April the 23rd struck a Sperm Whale, Lat 37.25 S. Long 49.00 W
April the 25th struck a Sperm Whale Lat 38.34 S Long 48.45 W

Sept the 3rd struck a right Whale, Lat 43.00, Long 78.10 W
Sept the 6th got a Whale Lat 42.50 Long 78.00 W
Sept the 7th struck a Whale Lat 43.50 Long 78.30 W
October the 29th struck 2 Whales got ones, Lat 43.25, the Sun in sight
October the 30th got a Whale Lat 43.10, the Sun in sight
November the 3rd struck a Whale Lat 43.45, Long 74.15 W
November the 4th got a Whale, Lat 43.40 Long 74.40 W
November the 8th got a Whale Lat 45.00 Long 75.35 W
November the 12 struck a Whale, Lat 43.40 Long 75.45 W
November the 15th got a Whale, Lat 44.00, Long 75.02 W
November the 20th struck a Whale Lat 43.30 Long 75.50 W
November the 23rd struck 2 Whales, got one, Lat 43.00 Long 75.58
December the 4th got a Whale, Lat 43.35 Long 76.25 W

January the 17th saw a Sperm Whale, Lat 45.03 Long 74.00 W
January the 18 saw a Whale, Lat 45.00 Long 78.50 W
January the 17th saw a school of Minnies struck one, Lat 44.19, Long 77.00
January the 28th saw a school of Whales got one, Lat 43.50, the Sun in sight
January the 30th saw a school of Whales got one Lat 43.58 Long 75.30 W
February the 1st to April the 8th took 400 lbs Sperm Oil, from
the Lat of 41.00 to 45.00, the Sun in sight most of the time
