Friday May 20th

This day commences with fine Pleasant weather from the North West Steering E by N employed in Braking, set ship's stores and working on the rigging, two ships in site going to the Eastward
Leat 37-58 Lon 66-40

Saturday May 21th

This day Begins with Pleasant weather and clear strong Breeze from the Westward Steering E by N employed in ship's duty, saw a ship Steering to the Eastward so ends this day
Leat 40-41 Lon 62-11

Sunday May 22th

This day commences with the Breeze from the S.W. very strong Steering E by N employed in ship's duty, saw a Steamer going to the Westward later part Wind shifted to West and squally, weather raining and so ends this day
Leat 42, 12 Lon 59-28

Monday May 20th

This day commences with fine sails from N.W. on the Starboard tack took in sake closed reefed the main topsail and posted the fore topsail later part Wind shifted to W.N.W. Steering E by N clear and Pleasant
Leat 42-47 Lon 57-15

Tuesday May 24th

This day commences with fresh Gales from the S.W. and shifted to N.W. clear Pleasant weather Steering E by N, & saw a ship going to the Westward employed in the rigging so ends this day
Leat 49-51 Lon 55-40

Wednesday May 25th

commences with fresh Breeze from the N.W. Steering E by N, & later part Wind shifted W by S Steering E by N clear pleasant weather employed on rigging, latter part light Winds
Leat 45-33 Lon 52-25 so ends this day
