Sunday 24th These 24 hours commence with strong gales from SSE heading E at 1 P.M. took in Fore and Mizzen Topsails Middle part lacing too under close reefed M. J. Sail & B. J. Mast Staysail Latter ^{rainy} part took in the B. Boat & turned up the W. Road

Monday 25th Still lacing too at 3 P.M. set the Fore Sail Middle part moderate set the Topsails Latter part light winds from ESE employed in breaking out for water and setting up S. Fore Rigging

Tuesday 26th These 24 hours commence with light winds from ESE heading S by E employed in setting up S. M. Rigging at 4 P.M. passed an English Barge steering W. N.W. Middle & Latter parts rainy

Wednesday 27th These 24 hours commence with light winds from W. S.W. steering ESE at 3 P.M. hoveed for Blackfish Middle part pleasant Latter part employed in bending studding sails and making Boat sails

Thursday 28th These 24 hours commence with light winds from S.W. steering SE by E employed in making boat sails Middle and Latter parts pleasant

Friday 29th These 24 hours commence with light winds from W. S.W. steering SE by E employed in fitting the rigging Middle part pleasant

Monday 2nd These 24 hours commence with strong winds from ESE steering SSE at 6 P.M. double reefed the Topsails Middle part took in Mizzen Sail Jib and Spanker Latter part rainy Lat 31.16

Tuesday 3rd These 24 hours commence with strong winds from ESE heading S with squalls of rain Middle part moderate Latter part employed in breaking out for water

Wednesday 4th These 24 hours commence with strong winds from ESE heading S employed in breaking out for water Middle part strong gales shortened sail to close reefed M. J. Sail & B. J. Mast Staysail Latter part moderate

Thursday 5th These 24 hours commence with strong winds from W steering SE by S at 3 P.M. made all sail Middle part pleasant Latter part employed in breaking out between decks

Friday 6th These 24 hours commence with light winds from W S.W. steering SE by S employed in breaking out between decks Middle part pleasant Latter part employed in fitting rigging

Saturday 7th Still light winds from ESE employed in fitting rigging at 6 P.M. spoke English Barge
