Thursday Oct. 2

Satter part at 9 A.M. got under way with light breezes from E. to S.E. standing out of Buzzards bay.

Friday Oct. 3

Light breezes from S.E. heading out S.S.W. at 5 A.M. the pilot left the middle part heading S.S.W. Satter part calm. Black island bearing N.W. 10 miles distant

Saturday Oct. 4

Round with light airs and calm - middle part light breezes from S.E. to E. Satter part fine breezes from N.W. steering E.S.E.

Lat in 40° 07' N.
Long. in 70° 08' W.

Sunday Oct. 5

All of these 24 hours fine breezes from N.W. steering E.S.E.

Monday Oct. 6

All of these 24 hours fine breezes from N. steering E by S.

All of these 24 hours fine breezes from N by E steering E by S.
