This day moderat winds from NW & W all
sail set to ESE people employed on the rigging
saw on sail standing on a wind to SW

thus ends Lat 39.18 Long 49.10
Remarks on board Thursday June 29th
This day first part strong gales from SW single
reef the middle and latter more moderate all
sail set to E by S & S saw one sail standing
on a wind to SW thus ends

Lat 39.35 Long 45.50
Remarks on board Friday June 30th
this day first and middle fresh gales
from the westward all sail set to ESE
at 12 saw 2 sail at sun set took in sail
and hoist two thus ends Hoob Lat
by ac 39.45 Long 42.40

Remarks on board Sat July 1st
This day first part moderate winds from SW
at day light made all sail on steered ESE
the middle wind lanting to S and some rain
the latter fresh winds and blowdy
thus ends Lat 39.30 Long 41.30

Remarks on board Sunday July 2nd
This day strong winds from S by E and a
plenty of rain at 4 PM saw sperm whale
laid killed one got her along side at 8 PM
and lost her from along side set single reef
top sails and stood on a wind thus ends
Hoob Lat by ac 40.00
Long 39.10

Remarks on board Monday July 3rd
this day comes in with moderat weather
at 9 found our whale took her along side
but her body in at sun set thus ends
Laying by the side Lat 40.20 Long 38.00

Remarks on board Tuesday July 4th
This day strong winds from NW at
day light commenced cutting the head at
12 got through and made sail to S
so ends employed at boiling

Lat 40.20 Long 37.30
Remarks on board Wednesday July 5th
This day moderate winds from W all sail set
to SE & E spoke ship for Decatur & ship John Dyer
of New Bedford no oil thus ends employed at boiling

Lat 39.56 Long 36.20
Remarks on board Thursday July 6th
This day light airs and calms all sail set to ESE
at 12 finished boiling Lat 39.20
Long 35.35

Remarks on board Friday July 7th
This day first and middle moderate winds
from S all sail set on a wind to ESE the
latter fresh winds coming to W thus ends
Lat 39.12 Long 33.50

Remarks on board Sat July 8th
This day moderate winds from S & W all
sail set to SE Lat 38.53
Long 30.35 at 4 PM

Remarks on board Sunday July 9th
at day light saw the Land at 12 came to
anchor in Fayall harbour in 20 fathoms of water
so ends the business of the day

Remarks on board Monday July 10th
This day Landed 55 bbls of oil and got our recruits

Tuesday July at 12 got under way the wind
to SW stood to the northward and passed between
Freshish & St George
