

Thursday Sept 1<sup>st</sup>

All this day moderate breeze from the E. with pleasant weather, saw porpoises and two seals. all hands employed in ships duty, took in mainsail at sunset.

Friday 2<sup>d</sup>

All this day moderate breeze from the East with fine weather, saw black fish lowered twice could not get fast, all hands employed in ships duty, took in mainsail at sunset.

Saturday 3<sup>d</sup>

All this day strong breeze varying from S. E. to S. W. with rain, set mainsail as usual, took it and flying jib in at sunset, saw one seal.

Sunday 4<sup>th</sup>

All this day strong breeze from the S. W. set mainsail, took it in at sunset also flying jib and reefed foresail.

Monday 5<sup>th</sup>

Strong breeze all this day from the S. W. weather good, made all sail did not shorten at sunset, Exchanged longitude with the Brig Acquidneck of Newport, we were 30 miles to the Westward of her by Chron.

Tuesday Sept 6<sup>th</sup>

All this day blowing a gale from the S. W. with very stormy weather. At 1 a.m. took in mainsail and flying jib, at 6 reefed foresail.

Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup>

All this day a gale from S. W. to N. W. and stormy, at 5 P.M. reefed trisail and jib.

Thursday 8<sup>th</sup>

All this day strong breeze from the N. E. with heavy sea, and good weather, made all sail at sunrise, at 9 a.m. took in main sail and set trisail, saw two seals.

Friday 9<sup>th</sup>

All this strong breeze from the East with good weather, did not set mainsail to day.

Saturday 10<sup>th</sup>

All this day strong breeze from the S. E. and quite rough, at 2 a.m. set main sail, saw two seals to day.

Sunday 11<sup>th</sup>

This day being moderate breeze from S. E. at 9 a.m. struck from N. N. W. and at 5 P.M. we were laying to under reefed fore and trisails, blowing again, weather squally.
