

Monday Sept 12

All this day strong breeze from the N.W. at 5 P.M. shook reef out of trisail and set gib., at 8 shook reef out of foresail.

Long 62° 19' West

Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup>

All this day strong breeze from the N.W. at 4 A.M. set two reefs mainsail and flying. at 6 set whole mainsail and gafftopsail. took in topsail at 11 A.M. and unbuttoned it as it was so poor. at 5 P.M. two reefs main and foresails, and set them, saw one sail.

Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup>

All this day moderate breeze from the S.W. with pleasant weather all hands employed in ship's duty.

Lat 40° 44' North  
Long 66° 00' West

Thursday 15<sup>th</sup>

All this day light air from N.W. with fine weather all hands employed in ship's duty saw a steamer steering S.W.

Friday 16<sup>th</sup>

All this day moderate breeze from the South with pleasant weather saw several fishermen to anchor.

Lat 42° 11' North  
Long 67° 23' West

Saturday Sept 17<sup>th</sup>

First part this day light breeze from the E.N.E. last part good breeze from the same way. saw a schooner and brig. weather looks threatening.

Lat 42° 14' North  
Long 68° 23' West

Sunday 18<sup>th</sup>

This day begins with strong breeze from the N.E. and at 7 A.M. blew a gale at 6 A.M. made the Highlands of Cape Cod, bearing S.W. 5 miles distant at 7 two reefs our mainsail at 9 two reefs our foresail and furled flying gib. came to anchor under Wood End with sheet anchor dragged so let go small at 3 P.M. took in our boats on deck blowing a perfect gale. At 11 P.M. got under way for Town.

Monday 19

Begins with pleasant breeze from N.W. and fine weather. at 1.20 A.M. came to anchor at Provincetown with One Hundred and Forty barrels Whale Oil so ends this voyage.
