

177 Remarks on Board of Bark Ocean

Thursday July 11th
First part Morrishute breeze from the S. E. at 9 o'clock A.M. Captain & pilot came on Board took anchor & made all sail steering to S.W. at 12 o'clock pilot left wind S.E. & at dusk Block Island light bearing W distant 12 miles

Friday 12th
First part calm with rain at 3 o'clock sprang up a light breeze from the E. N. E. Whittle part wind E. S. E. quite a number of sails in sight employed in fitting boats and other duties thick and rainy weather ship on different tasks working to the S.

Saturday 13th
Strong breeze from the N. E. course S. E. & under all sail crew employed in ships duties middle part the same latter part took in light sails & double reefed fore top sail to sea.

Sunday 14th
First part strong breeze from the E. N. E. course S. S. E. under double reefed middle part Morrishute made sail latter part pleasant to ends

Monday 15th
First part light breeze from the E. ship on different tasks a working to the windward crew employed in ships duties middle & latter part the same to ends

First part of the day commences with Morrishute breeze from the West with light rain small course E. S. E. crew employed in ships duties middle & latter the same

Wednesday 17th
Morrishute breeze from the S. W. course E. S. E. employed in ships duties to men till middle & latter the same

Thursday 18th
First part Morrishute breeze from the W. S. W. course S. E. all sail set crew employed in ships duties middle & latter the same

Friday 19th
First part Morrishute breeze from the W. S. W. course S. E. under all sail crew employed in ships duties middle & latter part the same to ends

Saturday 20th
Strong breeze from the W. course S. E. & all sail set crew employed in ships duties at 3 o'clock P.M. passed wreck of schooner Louisa Birdwell of the river N. J. in a water log condition to ends

Sunday 21st
Wind W. course S. E. & employed in ships duties middle & latter the same

Monday 22nd
Morrishute breeze all sail set course S. E. & employed in ships duties middle & latter the same
