First part light breeze from the S.E. W ship on P. tack by the wind heading S. E crew employed on ships duties Middle and latter the same worked sail at sundown so ends

Wednesday 28th

First part light breeze from the S. E. W ship on P. tack by the wind heading E. S. E Middle & latter the same so ends

Thursday 29th

Morrate breeze from the S. E. W ship on P. tack by the wind heading S. E Middle part rose blackfish did not lose latter part passed a whaling schooner so ends

Friday 30th

Calm crew employed on ships duties one sail in sight Middle & latter part the same

Saturday 31st

First part Calm Middle and latter the same one sail in sight Middle ends

Sunday 1st

First part light breeze from S. E ship on P. tack by the wind Middle part spoke schooner William Wilson latter calm so ends

Monday 2nd

First part Calm Middle part the same latter part spoke William Wilson calm so ends

Tuesday 3rd

Light breeze and calms one sail in sight employed on ships duties

First part Calm one sail in sight employed in setting up rigging Middle and latter part the same

Thursday Aug 1st

First part Morrate breeze from the W. S. W ship on P. tack by the wind heading S. E crew employed on ships duties one sail in sight Middle & latter the same

Friday 2nd

First part Morrate breeze from the W. S. W ship on P. tack by the wind heading to the S. W at 7 o'clock rose sperm & whales lost & struck loose whale parted line but succeeded in saving one latter part employed in cutting so ends

Saturday 3rd

First part Morrate breeze employed in Martin work & sails in sight ship on P. tack by the wind Middle & latter part employed in hoisting

Sunday 4th

First part Calm crew employed on ships duties Middle & latter part the same so ends

Monday 5th

First part Strong breeze from the S. E. W ship on P. tack by the wind Middle & latter part employed on ships duties

Tuesday 6th

Calm Middle & latter part employed in blowing down & cooping bread & flour so ends
