 and fine steering P. employed in fitting Boats  
 at 3 P.M. saw a Brig Bottom up Mid & Lotted  
 fine Pnd Lat 38.40 West  
 Long 66.30 West

Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> Customs Smith  
 First part fresh breeze from the N.E. and  
 cloudy steering E.P. Lotted much the same  
 Pnd Lat 38.02  
 Long 62.44

Monday 18<sup>th</sup>  
 First part fresh breeze from the North and  
 fine weather heading East by the wind  
 took in top gableut sails Pnd Lat 37.28

Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup>  
 First part light wind from the N.E. and  
 fine weather heading P.E. Pnd Lat 37.12

Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup>  
 Light breeze from the N.E. steering East  
 with all sail out Pnd Lat 38.02
