 August 24 These 24 hours Strong Breezes from
 S.W. Course & at 7 o'clock all
 topsails took in & furlail mainsail Lat 39.17.00
 to end the day Long 33.20.00

Friday
 August 25 These 24 hours Fine Breezes from S.W.
 with frequent showers of rain at 9 maid
 Flores & Larro a 12 nearly up with them
 at 4 P.M. out off sight of them & then
 run down for furlail under Double reef
 top sail jingle top maintop sail & furlail Lat 39.20.00
 & Stairail to end the day Long 31.20.00

Saturday
 August 26 These 24 hours Fine Breezes from
 W Course & by S at 10 maid Furlail
 run down by Pike St. Jorge with
 a fine Breeze Low to sail running Lat 38.52
 down between Pico & Fajal 50 end
 the day

Sunday
 August 27 These 24 hours Fine Breezes from S.W.
 Course & by S saw several sail of vessels
 stand to westward & eastward
 Brig Ships & Schooners saw above take
 aboard but down by St. Jorge & Governor
 to end the day
