 April 7
 These 24 hours light breeze of calm from
 all points of the compass at 7 AM evening
 up a light breeze from the N.W. course
 at 11 AM sent out 2000 yds of sail
 to end this day with a number of sails
 bound to the Mast

 Long 74 58 W

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Monday
 April 8
 These 24 hours strong breeze from the N.W.
 course N.E. by E at 11 AM spoke Philadelphia
 Pilot boat at 4 PM the wind shifted N.E. took
 ship N.W. at 8 PM spoke the schooner light
 house bore N.W. by W at 20 miles to end
 this day

 These 24 hours light breeze from all points
 of the compass at 4 PM got Steeringsails
 course N.E. Windy & 9 AM a number of sails

 Bound to Providence to end this day
 Lat 39 54 N
 Long 74 07 W

Wednesday
 April 10
 These 24 hours breeze of pleasant weather
 from the N.W. course N.E. to end this day
 Lat 39 57 N
 Long 72 41 W

Thursday
 April 11
 These 24 hours fresh breeze from the N.W.
 course N.E. at 2 PM made the land
 of Long Island at 5 PM made the
 island at 7 took a pilot of the shore
 N.W. by E at 8 PM got the ship along
 side the wharf heeled and discharged
 all hand to end this day
 Measures 3 30
 bush wheat 1 50
 salt salaratus 37
 bushel of corn
