Middle part wind hauled to the North... a gale... lightning at 2 P.M. appeared a heavy squall of hail... the wind shifted to West...

Latter part... Moderating... the wind light and from the North...

Thursday the 1st

First part light air from the North... at night squally double peaked... at midnight... the Ship...

Middle part wind hauled to the Westward... Steering... Course...

Latter part... light off... the Ship... a cold fog... plenty of hail
