rain employed in cooping the bit. Steering

Wednesday July 22<sup>th</sup> Continues light breezes  
from the Westward steering S. E. at 7 P.M. Spoke  
a German Brig from Buenos Aires bound to  
Palmouth England moderate breezes and  
fine weather the rest of this day steering  
S. E. Watching employed variously
