

Remarks on Board of Bark Pacific J. R. Allen

Saturday July 29<sup>th</sup> 1853

Continuing fine weather and cool breezes from the South steering by the wind to W. S. W. in company with Corned, Middle and Gutter part fresh breeze from South heading W. S. W. and E. S. E. employed variously. Saw Campuses & 3 Sails No Obs

Sunday July 30<sup>th</sup>

Continuing fresh breeze from the South heading W. S. W. and E. S. E. taking ship occasionally 3 Sails. I exchanged signals with a French man. 11 P.M. spoke Bark Hosen. Macomber of N. B. 18 Gays from home 10 Mts S. C. and no Gutter. Middle and Gutter part strong breeze and squally from the South heading on opposite tacks. Saw 2 Whips. 20 ends

Latitude Obs 40° 58' N. Longitude Obs 45° 25' W

Monday July 31<sup>st</sup>

First part light breeze and squally of rain heading to the Westward. Middle part fresh breeze and squally with showers of rain from S. E. steering S. S. W. Gutter part fresh breeze from S. E. steering W. S. W. Watches variously employed

Latitude Obs 39° 20' N. Longitude Obs 46° 50' W

Tuesday August 1<sup>st</sup> 1853

Continuing fresh breeze from S. E. steering W. S. W. Middle part strong breeze heading S. S. W. Gutter part moderate breeze from S. E. heading N. E. by E. & N. E. & employed variously. Nothing in sight. Watches of remarks

Latitude Obs 38° 40' N. Longitude Obs 46° 45' W

Wednesday Aug 2<sup>d</sup>

Continuing moderate breezes from S. E. heading E. N. E. Middle part strong Under short sail Gutter part strong breeze from S. E. heading to the E. N. E. 2 Whips in sight

Latitude Obs 39° 12' N. Longitude Obs 45° 14' W

Master Cruising for Spine Whales Atlantic Ocean

Thursday August 3<sup>d</sup> 1853

Continuing strong breeze from S. E. heading N. E. by E. Middle part took in all sail. Gutter fine weather wind East heading N. N. E. Nothing in sight. Watches employed in various jobs

Latitude Obs 39° 39' N. Longitude Obs 44° 37' W

Friday Aug 4<sup>th</sup>

Fine weather the first part of this day wind East heading E. S. E. Middle and Gutter part light breeze from the North heading to the Eastward

Saw Blackfish lowered for them noys. took up boats Gutter by Obs 39° 40' Longitude Obs 45° 20' W

Saturday Aug 5<sup>th</sup>

Continuing light breeze from N. E. heading E. S. E. by the wind. 7 Sails spoke Bark Vigilant of N. B. Whills. 3 me cut vectors sperm oil. Middle and Gutter light breeze and calm heading various ways

Latitude Obs 39° 22' N. Longitude Obs 45° 50' W

Sunday Aug 6<sup>th</sup>

Calm the first part of this day Middle and Gutter part light breeze from the Southward heading to the S. E. Nothing in sight

Latitude Obs 38° 45' N. Longitude Obs 45° 07' W

Monday Aug 7<sup>th</sup>

Commenced light air from the E. S. E. heading South. Middle part light breeze. Gutter part moderate breeze from W. S. W. steering various courses. Saw 1 Ship. Employed in sundry jobs to ends

Latitude Obs 38° 40' N. Longitude Obs 42° 53' W

Tuesday Aug 8<sup>th</sup>

Commenced moderate breezes from N. W. heading N. W. Middle part steering E. N. E. Gutter part light breeze inclining to a calm heading E. N. E. Employed sitting up backstays forward aft and fore and aft stays saw 1 Ship
