26 hours

Remarks on Board Wednesday October 18

This Day Begin with Light W S W Winds and  
pleasant weather and Working out the Bay At  
4 P M got the Wind from the N E and Steering  
S W by E and by 7 in the Evening Charge the Pilot and Steer  
S W per Compass and took the anchor on the  
Deck at 9 P M Came on fresh gales and doubled  
Keeped the top Sail Middle part gale Moderate  
at 10 P M Got all Sail 1 P M of Portuguese  
Boat Steer by the name of San fell from the  
Main top Mast head in to the Mast head  
he Die in 1 half hour it appeared he  
Broke his Log Sutter part fine weather Sea  
Sett 29 29 N Long 69 59 W

S E by E per Compass all Sail set both  
run way 9 A M Bury Lee Portuguese Boat  
Steer Sutter part fresh gales from the  
N N W with Rain weather and all hands
