

Friday April 21th 1837 2

At 8 O'clock P.M. Got under weigh with a Lite
Wind from the North Stood out of the Harbour
at 12 O'clock Wind S.W. and Light Beat
a cross of the Bay at 10 O'clock Came to about
2 Miles to the Westward of Duck's Hole In 10 fathoms
of water Suckey Bottom

Saturday April 22th 1837

Strong Breeze from the North at 5 O'clock P.M.
Got under weigh and went through Duck's Hole
at 10 O'clock Nonnans Lands Bore S.W. Distance
6 Leagues from which I take my Departure In
the Latitude 41.15 N Long 70.49

Lat In 40.55 N
Long In 71.23 W

Sunday April 23th 1837

Commencement of these 24 Hours Brisk Breezes
And clear from West to Westward standing to the
Westward Middle Part Moderate

Latter Part Strong Breezes and Cloudy
Wind S.W. Saw several Sails to Ends these 24
Hours

This Day Got No Ob
