 latter part moderate breezes from S.W. and cloudy
 Latitude 6.14 North Long by Ac 39.50 W
 Saturday September 8
 First part fair weather wind S.W. middle part
 much rain with variable winds and light
 latter part fair weather with moderate breezes
 South Latitude by Obs 7.24 North Long by Ac 40.20 W
 Sunday September 9
 All these 24 hours light breezes and variable from
 the Southward steering N.W. Lat 8.19 Long by Ac 40.55 W
 Monday September 10
 First part light breezes from the South with showers
 of rain, at 4 p.m. saw a school of blackfish, lowered
 a boat to catch one, but instead of a blackfish, saw
 a porpoise. Middle part calm latter equally
 fresh breezes in the squalls, the intervals calm, wh
 hich was the greatest part of the time Lat 8.48 Long 41.00 W
 Tuesday September 11
 All these 24 hours, the weather has been very variable
 some of the time calm, then fresh breezes, and
 most of the time hard rain Lat 9.44 Long
 Wednesday September 12
 First part light air from the Eastward with rain
 middle part calm latter part gentle breezes from
 S.W. with fair weather steering N.W. Lat 10.53 Long
 Thursday September 13
 First part light air from South and S.W. middle
 part calm latter part light breezes from the Eastward
 with pleasant weather Latitude 11.31 Long
 Friday September 14
 First and middle part light breezes from South
 and S.W. latter part fair trades with fair weather
 employed a painter Lat 12.13 Long by Ac

 sprung in the latter fair wind S.W. immediately repaired main
