reefed top sail two sails in sight  
of the weather ~~down~~ all well  
the ship came past just clear of us

ship under two close reefed top sail  
all hands employed in ship duty

Saturday 8th  
This day <sup>commencing</sup> with fine weather  
winds southeast gave the boat ready
