

Ship Pacific of New Bedford
On A Whaling Voyage Homeward Bound
Master Sailed August 16th 1842

Sunday October 16th 1842

These 24 hours commences with strong breezes from S E W and over cast weather steering steering S 8° W with all sail set middle part light squalls of rain wind hails to southward and westward latter part steering 8° S close hauled to the wind with all running sail set

Sat 24 15 S
Sun 22 2 W

Monday October 17 1842

These 24 hours commences with strong breeze from S and pleasant weather steering 8° S with all running sail set 8 P.M. tacked ship middle and latter ship close hauled to the wind with all sail set

Sat 26 6 S
Sun 21 10 W

Tuesday October 18th 1842

These 24 hours commences with light winds from southward and eastward with pleasant weather steering S middle part strong breeze from S E latter part wind N N W steering S S S with all sail set at 2 P.M. have the log found she was going at the rate of 8 miles per hour men employed at ships duty so ends these 24 hours
