

July 1859  
Bank Per of Wantuckret Thimierard Bausel  
Friday 29<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with strong breeze from the W heading  
By the wind to the NW Middle part light  
Breezes from the S W then W W under all  
Sail better part light breezes from the S S W  
at 6 AM took Pilot boat 063 of Head yard  
at 7 Sounded & got 41 fathoms of Water Muddy  
Bottom

Lat 40-38 W Long 71-17

Saturday 30<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with light breeze from the S S W  
steering W W at 2 PM set W W Middle  
part at 10 O'clock took paye lug too in the  
Head yard's aback to the W at 1 o'clock were  
slip to the E and by black better steer W  
wind & thick fog 22 fathoms of Water

Lat W Long

Sunday July 31<sup>st</sup>

Commenced with light breeze from the S steering  
W W at 10 AM clear weather saw gay Head W W  
at mid day at 1 PM took a Pilot and steer up  
the Sound at sunset Anchor in "Haline" Hall  
Middle the same better part at daylight got  
under way for Wantuckret wind light and baffling

Lat W Long

Monday Aug 1<sup>st</sup> 1859

Commenced with light baffling winds at 10 PM Calm  
Anchor in 16 fathoms of Water off the Cross Rip  
Shoal at 6 PM took a breeze from the W W with  
rain got underway at 9 in the Evening at the  
Bar in 7 fathoms of Water the Ship heaving 1000  
& started in 24 hours
