4th At 9 a.m. got on board took our anchor &
 put to sea, strong gales at N. to N. W. Went
 out in company with Ships *Young*
Astor & *Reindeer*

Wednesday 5th

5th Strong increasing gales from N. to N. W.
 hauled to sails & fly jib, at 2 discharged
 pilot & bid adieu to friends, at 3 tacked to
 the S & made sail, at 5 Roman Land Rearing
 S. Lashed across uncut & stored away cables
 Steering S. E. double reefed top sails, Middle
 part fine, latter part do, fitting boats

Thursday 6th Long 68 10

6th Strong gales at S to S W all sail set fitting boats
 to Middle part equally at 10 double reefed
 top sails, at 11 hauled main sail fore & mizen
 top sails, wind to N W we S E, at daylight
 set double reefed fore top sail clearing up
 latter part strong gales very dugged,

Long 68 28 Lat 38 50

Friday 7th

7th Strong gales from N W we S E by E, main
 top sail set, very dugged down, Rottamy, Shipping
 a great deal of water, Middle & latter part the
 same

Saturday 8th

8th Strong gales from the N W we S E all sail set
 Middle part the same latter do fine all sail
 set fitting boats &c, found all my lines wet in
 the run
