

Bark Tinner Bound on A Whaling voyage  
August the 14 1877

the  
Tuesday 14 light breeze from SSW  
at 9 A.M. got under way and  
took the steam tug at 2 P.M.  
let go of the tug of the saw &  
logs and discharged the pilot  
latter part lashed and retacked  
so ends Date 00004

the  
Wednesday 15 light breeze from  
SSW lashed and retacked at 10  
A.M. saw gannets and terns  
land bearing 60° E so ends  
Date 000045

the  
Thursday 16 light breeze and variable  
lashed and retacked saw  
11 sails so ends  
Lat 40 24 Long 70 28 Date 0005

the  
Friday 17 light breeze from SSW  
heading S E saw 2 sails so ends  
Lat 38 52 Long 68 41 Date 00055

the  
Saturday 18 light breeze from S  
heading S E saw one sail so ends  
Lat 38 16 Long 67 37 Date 0006

the  
Sunday 19 light air from SSW  
steering S E saw nothing  
so ends Date 00065

the  
Monday 20 light air and  
variable course S E and S E  
by S so ends so ends  
Date 0007
